To whom it may concern:

Creation Books published my 294-page book *Anarchy and Alchemy: The Films of Alejandro Jodorowsky* in 2007, as the sixth entry in their ongoing 'Persistence of Vision' series.

The terms of my contract were £1000 on delivery of final copy and 7.5% on all book sales, with regular sales accounts to be supplied. I have a hard copy of this agreement.

In February 2007, a limited edition of 50 Jodorowsky-signed copies went on sale, followed in April 2007 by the full print run on sale for £14.95/\$19.95. Since then the book has sold out in the UK and US territories and gone out of print – prices now reach between \$120 and \$300 on Amazon and other online marketplaces.

As of today, I have only ever received a single payment of £500 on delivery of the finished manuscript. I have never received royalties or any account documentation from Creation Books and after years of hounding James Williamson to honour, at the very least, the outstanding £500 from our original agreement, I have simply been told that he cannot afford to pay me. I have a chain of email correspondence with James Williamson to support this.

The book took four years to research and complete – a process that personally cost me thousands of pounds – so any help recouping the royalties owed to me would be greatly appreciated.
